Overnight stay:

We reserved some lovely restored rooms in the monastery and have space for \sim 70 people. We have rooms with showers and rooms with common showers (with single shower cubicle). A washbasin is provided in every room (with warm and cold water). A bathrobe offers additional comfort.

Overnight rate: according to requirements a room costs 38 or 50 euro per person, including a full breakfast buffet.

Please reserve your room after you received our confirmation of participation. With the confirmation you will receive further information regarding the rooms, the terms and conditions of cancellation. There you can also find other accommodations in the region if needed.

Subsistence:

Corona:

Due to additional organization, the proof of vaccination or recovery (no older than six months old but at least 14 days) is required for the participation. Thank you for understanding.

Should the restrictions be tightened again in September and if it's not possible for our event to take place with the planned terms there is going to be an annulment of the agreement with the monastery, and the paid fee will be refunded completely.

Every year I visit Buenos Aires for dancing, studying the real way of playing music and to get basic knowledge of tango music. As a DJ I try to create an harmonic atmosphere but on the other hand to put in some contrast as well. Because of that variety it's never boring. When I play I try to put in the wide range that Tango music has to offer: variety of styles, with rhythmic, romantic, complex, dramatic Tangos. The contrast from Tanda to Tanda always with an eye on the atmosphere and energy in the Ronda. I place stylistic focus points with using tenderness, cheekiness and artfulness more then over the top and bulky melodies.

Predominately I choose music from the 1930 to the 1945 but as well some from the 20's and in small amounts dramatic and sweet inputs from later times.

I especially love Aníbal Troilo from the orchestras, his music should be played at every Milonga.


I started playing in 2004, first in Munich then national and international. In Munich I'm organizing a Milonga myself with the name "Bailongo im Giesinger Bahnhof".

With a selection of solid not too complex music in the beginning of the Milonga I try to create an easy and comfortable entrance for everyone. My goal is a fair balance of Tandas during the course of the Milonga. It is also important for me to finish the event harmonically.

I play strictly for dancing, so there are no surprises and newness in between. I'm choosing suitable and not too energetic Cortinas, using a short signal with carefully selected components to transport the signal in a save way to the participants.

My goal is a cross section of brilliant music of the épocha de oro and to arrange that in the most ideal way. At best I will disappear behind the music and get invisible, then I achieved my personal aim ...
